### **Current Role**

I am currently an Engineer in the Melbourne Defence Team. As part of this role, I have already supported numerous projects including the development of an energy network model, researching the safety of Autonomous Systems, and supporting the Defence Innovation Hub. In addition to the technical work, all engineers at Frazer-Nash take responsibility for the management of their own projects, giving me exposure to the commercial side of engineering consultancy.

## Why did you choose Frazer-Nash?

From the experience gained through studies and extracurricular activities, I had a strong interest in modelling problems and Systems Engineering approaches to engineering problems.
